This Admissions Agreement is to clarify the expectations and standards for all students attending Meridian Medical Arts Charter High School (MMACHS). The following expectations meet our charter school policies and are expected of all students.

- Students will attend school from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. In district students, transportation will be provided to and from student's home school. Out of district students are responsible from transportation.
Students will be responsible to be on time for school and their individual classes. On the 4th tardy, students will lose credit.
Students will take an active role in the cooperative group and oral learning experiences that are assigned for class activities.
Students will complete all assignments in a timely fashion.
Students are required to adhere to all discipline rules/policies as described in the student handbook.
Students will complete all tests and evaluations as required for their IEP, 504, and the school.

The following are the standards for our school. Your initials indicate your understanding and agreement with each standard.

Students will follow the board approved attendance policy (there are no excused absences at MMACHS). Six absences per semester are allowed and parents must call in. After the sixth absence, the student will need to report to the MMACHS committee.

I have been shown the grading scale for MMACHS and understand I must achieve a 74% or higher for a final grade in each class, in order to be eligible for credit. A "WIP" at semester will result in a "NC" no credit given for course.

There is a two-step discipline policy with a behavior contract for step two. If the behavior contract is not followed by the student, the student must return to their home high school.

Four years (8 credits) of science and four years (8 credits) of math are required to graduate, starting with at least Algebra I. Summer school or other pre-approved courses are recommended if the student is not ready for Algebra I.

If a student receives a "NC" no credit they must make up the class and provide the school with documentation of receiving credit before May 1st or August 1st or they will not be attending MMACHS the next school year. No more than 6 pre-approved courses may be taken outside of MMACHS direct instruction. No more than 2 in any one subject area.

I am aware of the 20 hour community service requirement and understand it must be completed by the end of the 10th grade.

I am aware that I must provide my own transportation to Job Shadowing experiences during the junior year.

Students must meet clinical standards for completing an internship in their career pathway during their senior year.

I am aware, that clinical hours outside the regular school day will be required and that I must provide my own transportation.

I understand that changing schools may result in classes being retaken or additional classes being required.

I understand that sensitive and ethical issues will be discussed at MMACHS.

I understand a dress code is required for the health profession and all students will participate on professional dress days.
